

Delaware Workers' Compensation Requirements

For Delaware Businesses

Do I need a Workers' Compensation policy?

Any Delaware employer with employees working within the State must have a Delaware Workers' Compensation policy.

For Out-of-State Businesses

What is required to provide proof of Workers' Compensation?

An actual Delaware workers' compensation policy covering activities in Delaware, OR

An out-of-state policy with a written endorsement covering Delaware activities



The insurance company must:

- Be licensed in the State of Delaware
- Be qualified by the Delaware Office of Workers' Compensation
- Have membership with the Delaware Compensation Rating Bureau

Policy Requirements

- Your policy must specifically list Delaware in section 3A as a covered state
- "All states" coverage is NOT acceptable

Important Notes

- Certificates of Liability are NOT accepted as proof of coverage
- Provide a copy of the Declaration Page or full Workers' Compensation insurance policy as proof
